



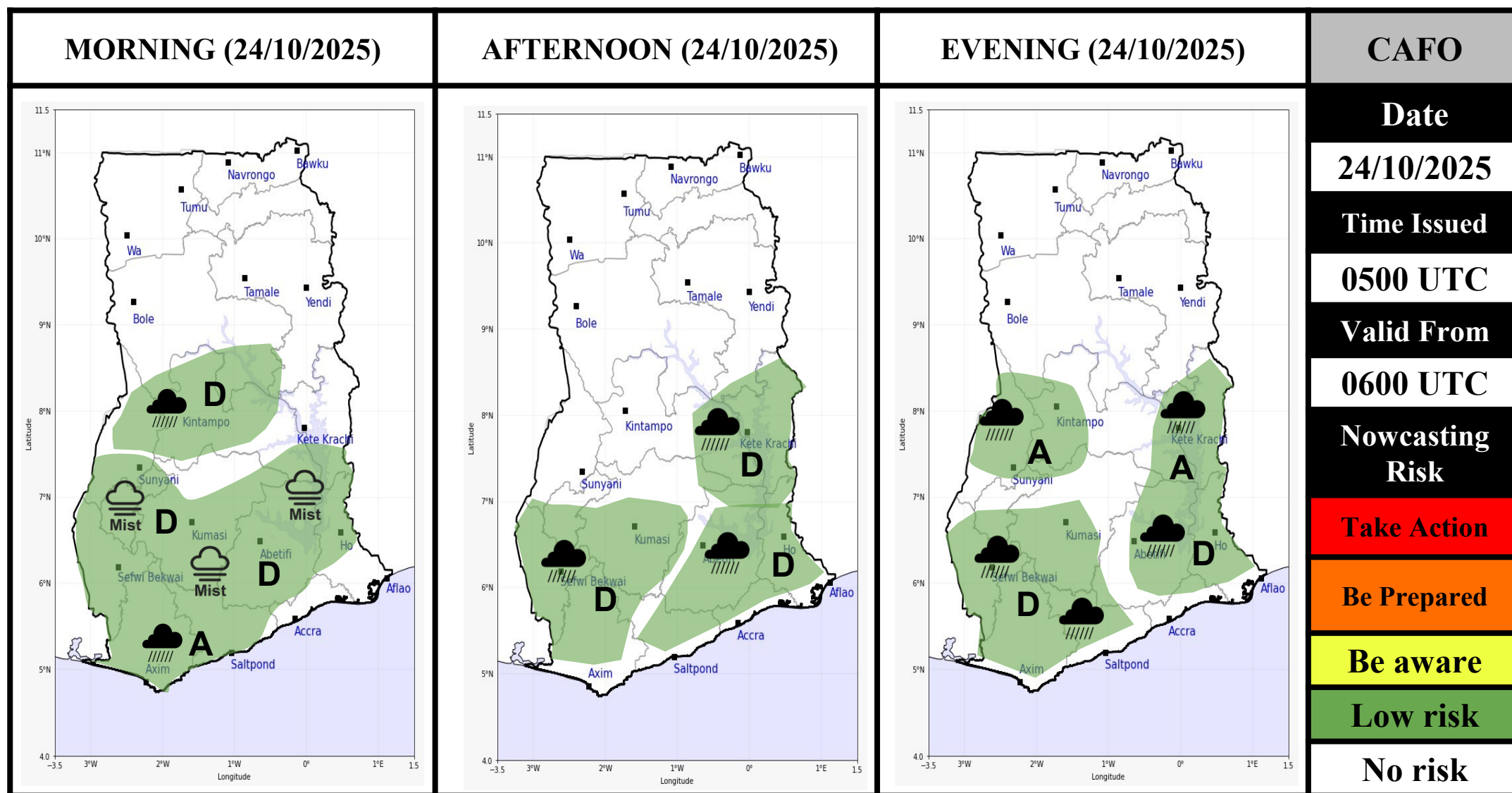
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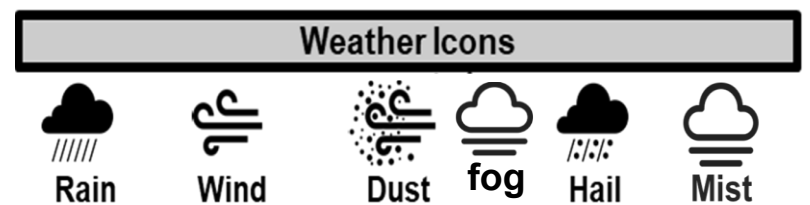

SUMMARY: Mist or fog patches are expected to develop early this morning over areas along the coast, mountainous and forest zones, while partly cloudy conditions prevail across most parts of the country. Thunderstorms or rain currently affecting portions of the transition sector (Dama Nkwanta, Abease, Adapdrase, Apesika and environs) is likely to persist over a few areas this morning. As the day advances into the afternoon, sunny weather will dominate over a large part of the country. However, from late afternoon into the evening, some places in the southern half of the country (Volta, Ashanti, Eastern, Western North, Bono and Ahafo regions) are likely to experience thunderstorms or rain of varying intensities.
