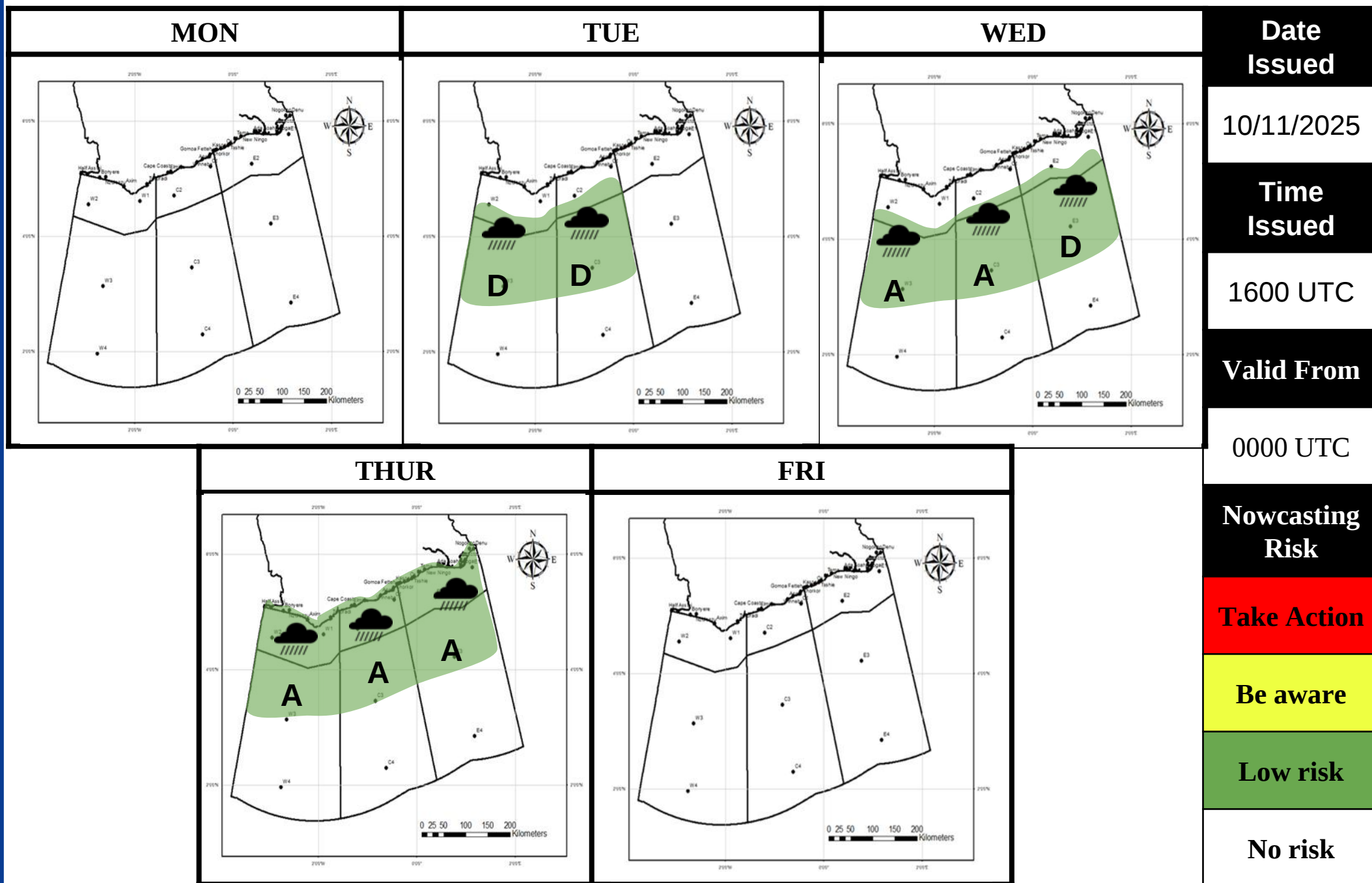


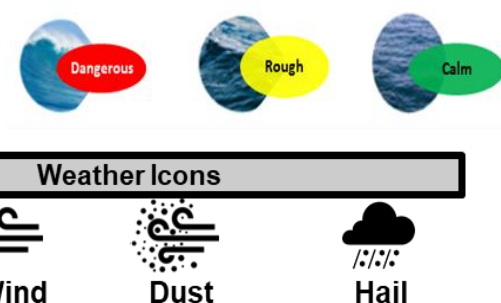

WEATHER SUMMARY
