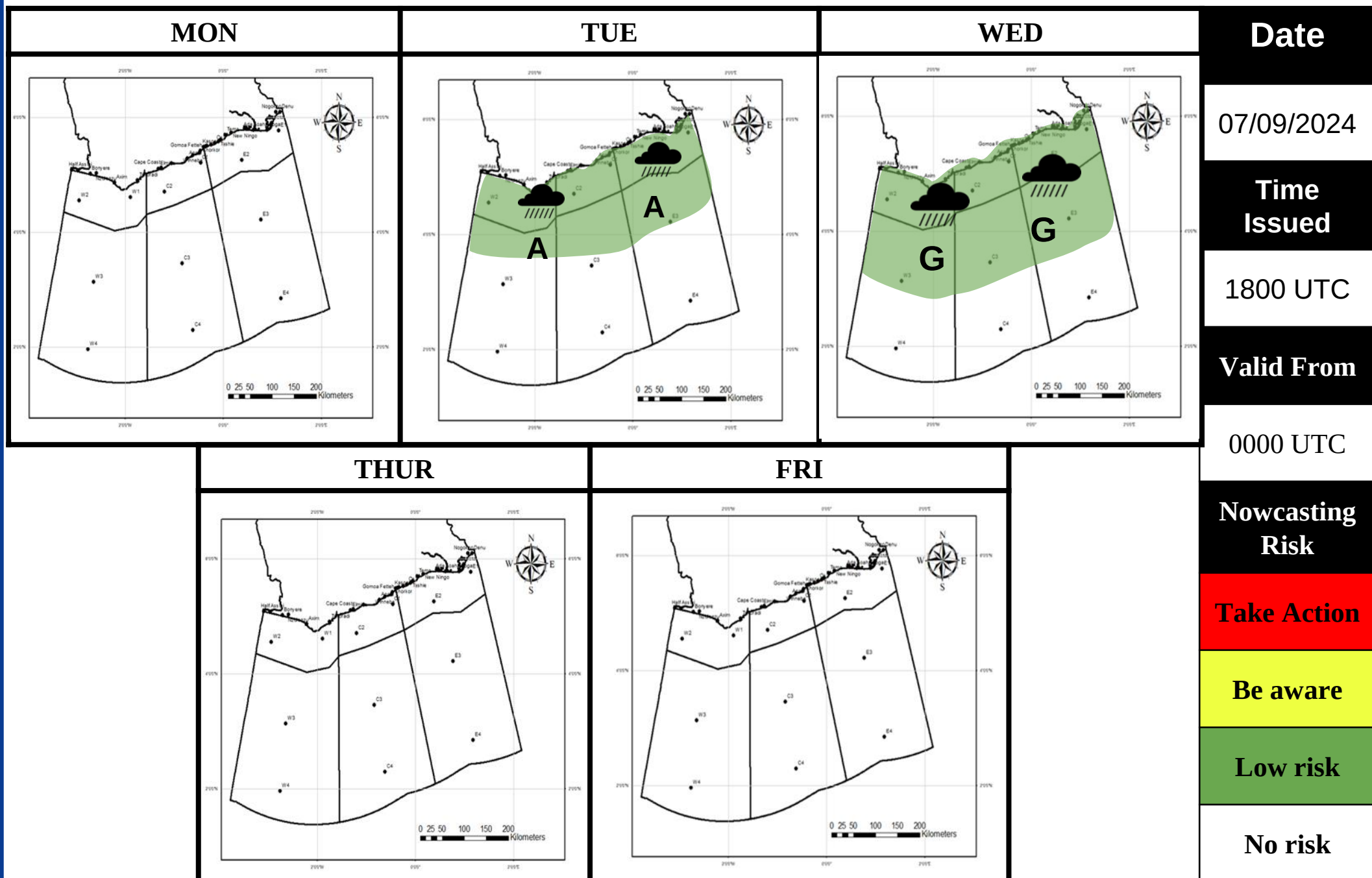

WEATHER SUMMARY

Rough sea state is expected from the start of the validity period through to the end of the first 48hours of the advisory, giving way to Calm conditions from the midweek to the end of the period. Mostly cloudy weather condition is forecast to occur between 48 to 72 hours of the advisory with possibility of light to moderate rains over the marine space.
