



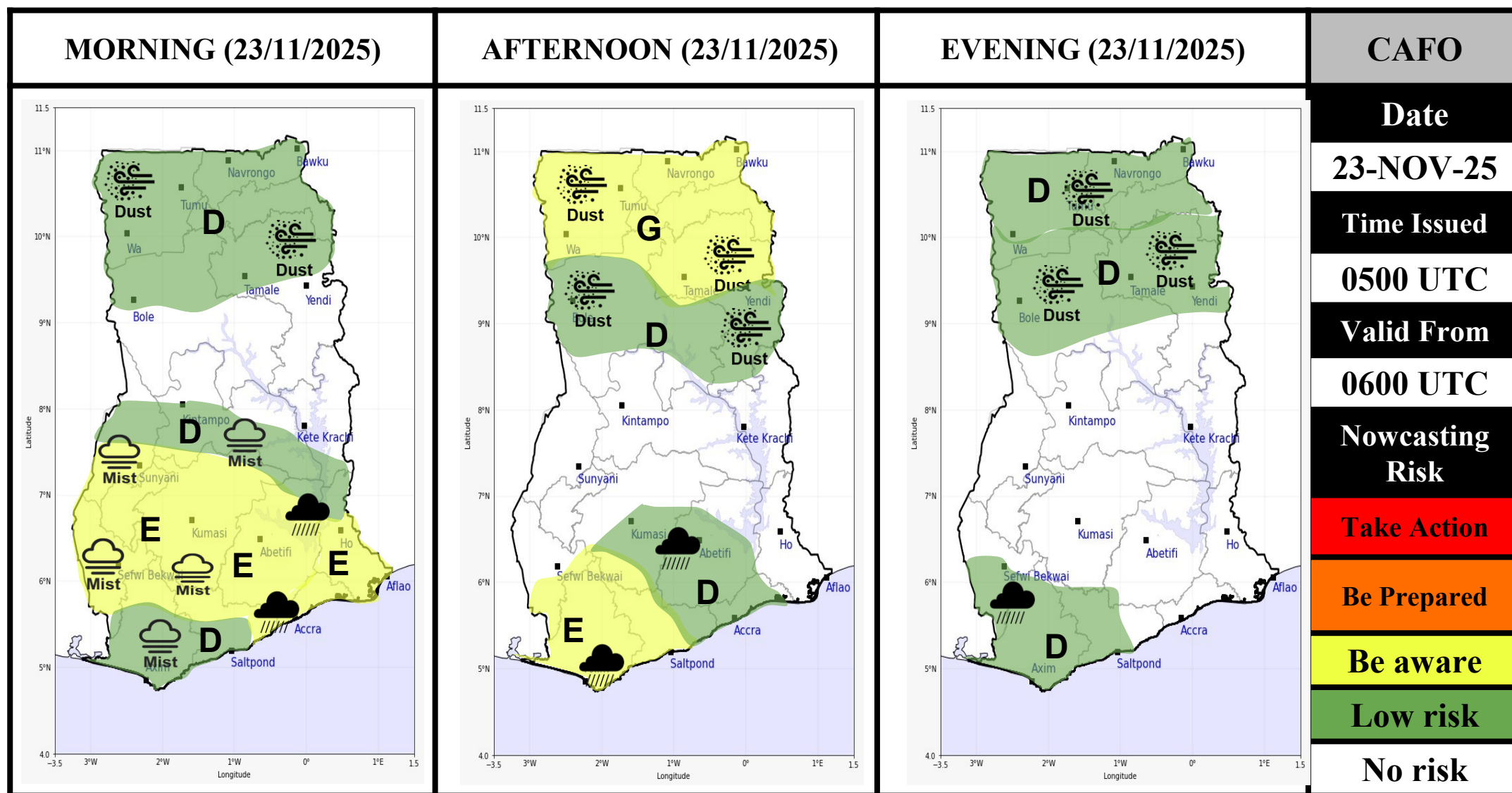
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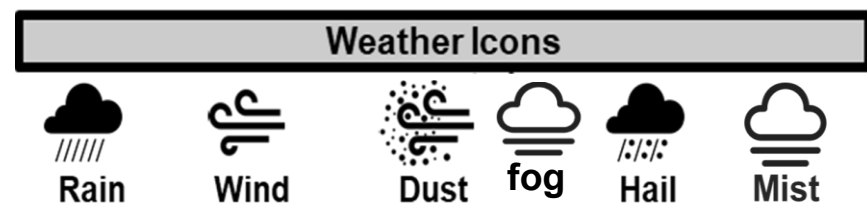

SUMMARY: A band of thunder and rain bearing clouds currently situated over southern Benin is expected to propagate westward into our country. It is likely to cast cloudiness and produce thunderstorms or rain of varying intensity along the coastal and inland areas from this morning into the afternoon. The remaining portions of southern Ghana will experience partly cloudy conditions with some localised thunderstorms or rain later in the day. The northern sector will remain fairly dry with slight haze throughout the forecast period. Misty or foggy conditions will reduce visibility within the forest and hilly places during the early hours of the day.

NB: Relatively cool night temperatures are expected over the upper regions.
