





SUMMARY: Whereas the southern half of the country will be predominantly misty or foggy in the early hours of the morning, varying intensity of dry and hazy weather will prevail over the northern sector of the country throughout the forecast period amidst hot temperatures in the afternoon. However, the misty or foggy conditions will clear and give way to mostly sunny periods with the likelihood of late afternoon localised thunderstorms or rain over parts of the inland and the forest belt (*Adaklu Waya, Mafi Kumase, Peki, Ave Dakpa, Oyoko, Kibi, Kwamang, New Tafo, Somanaya, Dodowa, Abokobi, Adjen Kotoku, Assin Fosu, Asankragua, Enchi and their surroundings*)

NB: Relatively cool night and early morning temperatures are expected over the upper regions.
