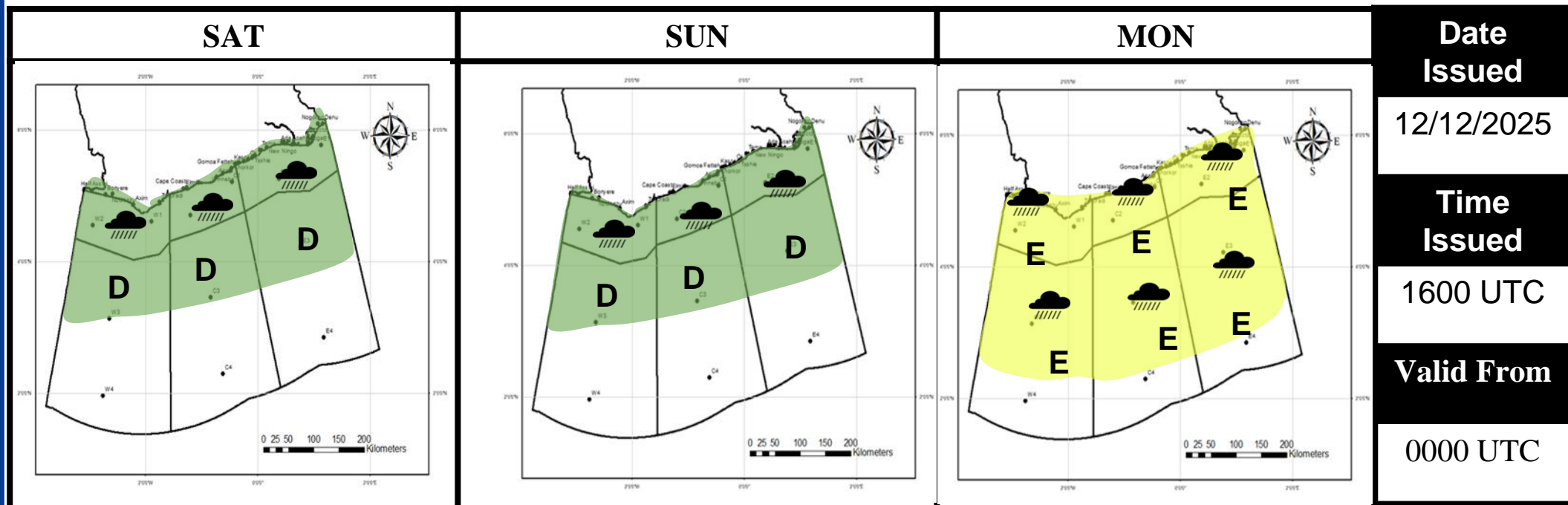

WEATHER SUMMARY

The country's maritime space is anticipated to be variably cloudy over the weekend, with periods of afternoon sunshine. Nonetheless, there is a 40-60% likelihood of rain of varying intensities, possibly accompanied by isolated thunderstorms affecting both onshore and offshore areas during the forecast period. The state of the sea is expected to be calm on Saturday and gradually become rough on Sunday and Monday.
