

SUMMARY: In the early hours of the morning, extensive mist or fog patches are expected to prevail across coastal, mountainous, and forested areas, resulting in reduced visibility. As the day progresses, these conditions are anticipated to dissipate, giving way to predominantly sunny weather across the country, accompanied by varying degrees of temperatures into the afternoon. The northern sector will remain fairly dry with slight haziness throughout the forecast period, while localized thunderstorms or rainfall are likely to occur later in the day within the transition zone, the middle belt, and inland portions of the coastal areas.

NB: *Relatively cool night and early morning temperatures are expected over the upper regions.*
