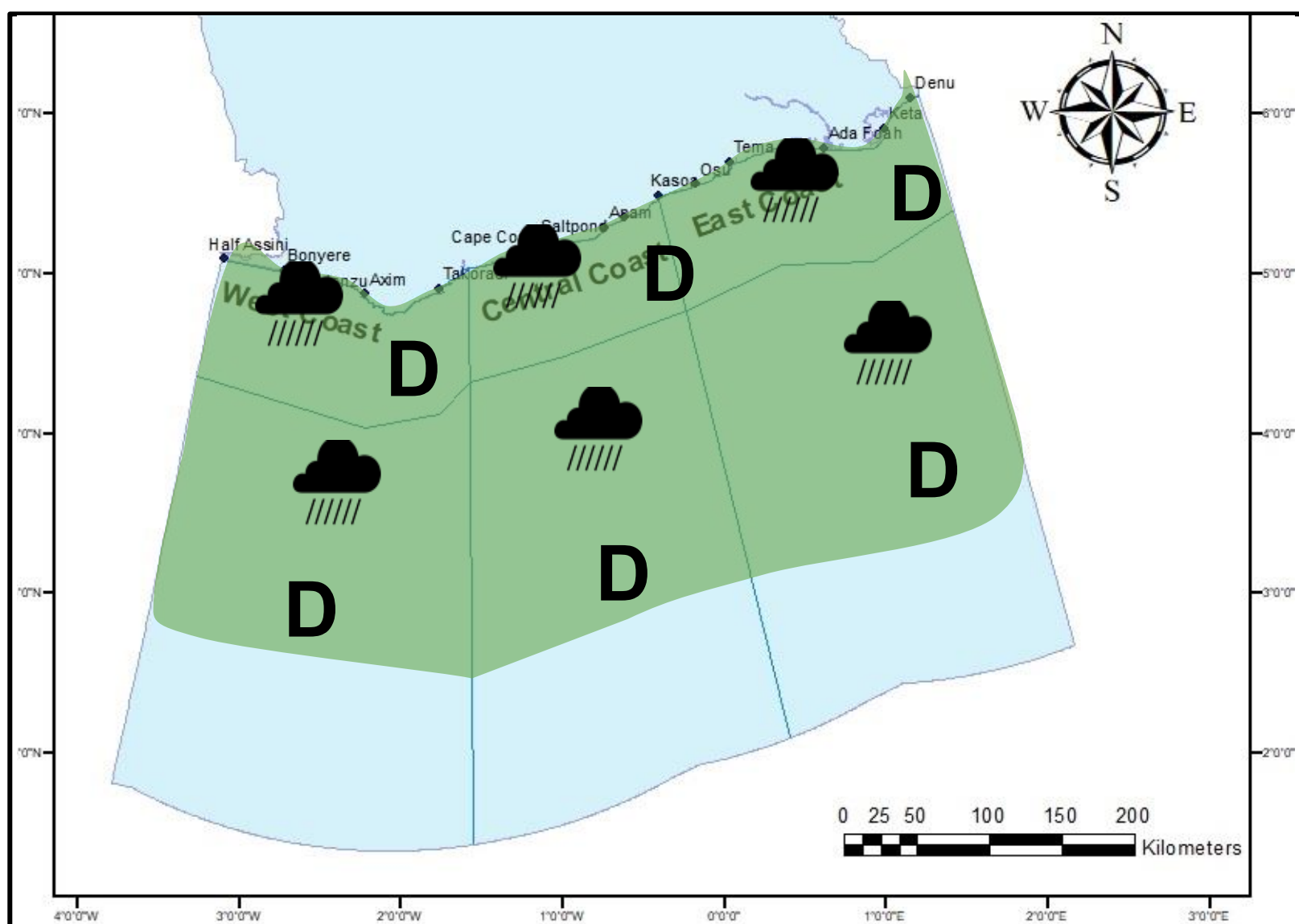

**WEATHER SUMMARY:** Mostly cloudy conditions with sunny intervals are expected over the country's marine waters this afternoon. There is a 40% chance of rain and thunderstorms along the east and central coasts early in the afternoon, shifting to the west coast from midafternoon into the early evening. Isolated thunderstorms and rain are also expected offshore from the afternoon through late evening.
