




## INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

### WEATHER SUMMARY

The weather over the lake and its surrounding communities is expected to be variably cloudy throughout the forecast period, with a 30% chance of isolated light rain and thunderstorms over parts of the southern sector tonight. Early morning mist may reduce visibility across the mid and southern lake areas. Meanwhile, dry and hazy conditions over the northern sector are expected to intensify and gradually spread southward during the forecast period.
