



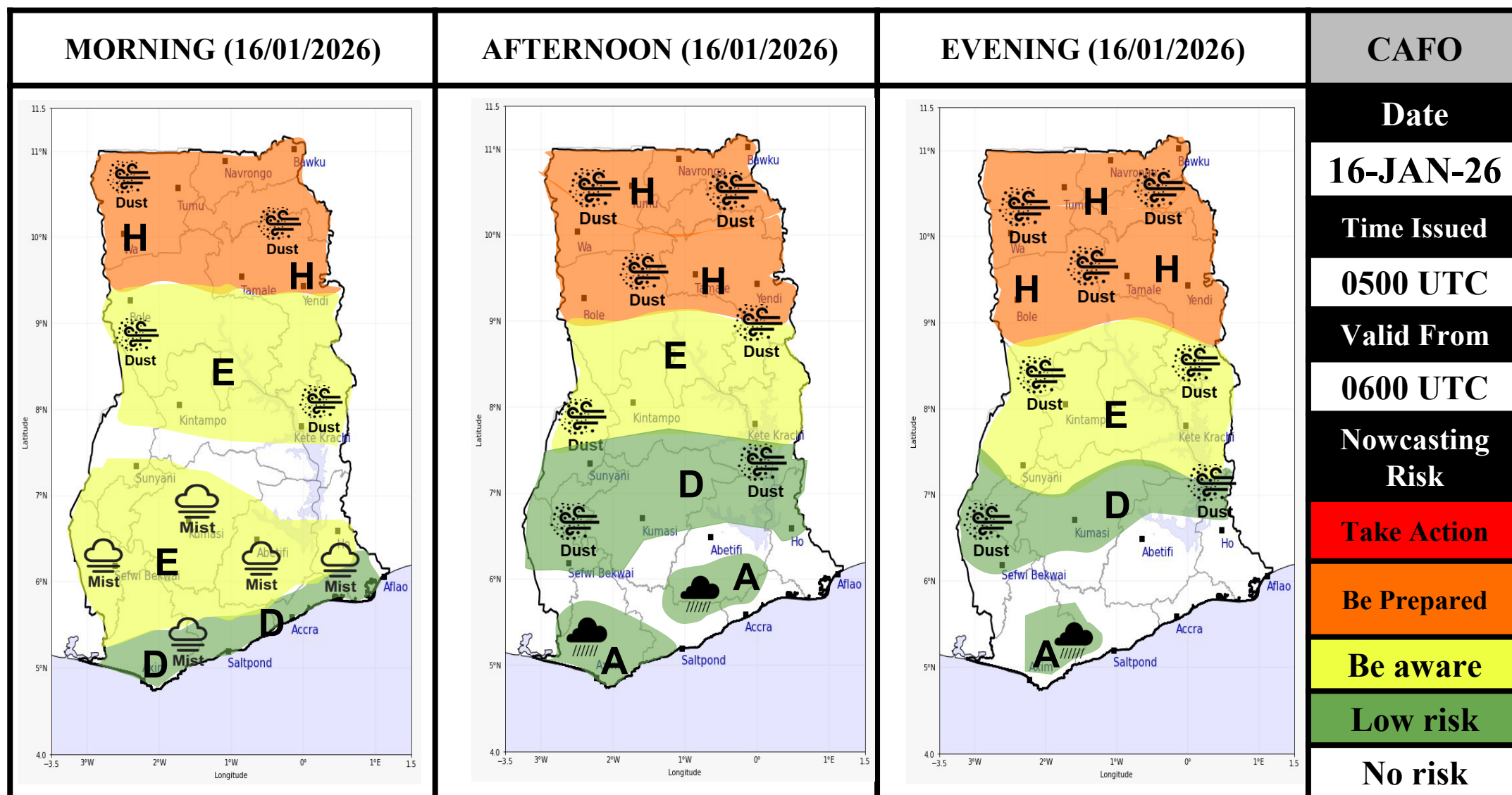

**SUMMARY:** This morning mist or fog conditions will dominate over southern Ghana whereas the north half will experience dry and hazy conditions throughout the forecast period. These weather conditions are expected to reduce visibility range this morning and into the afternoon. As the day progress, mostly sunny conditions with few clouds are anticipated over most places with varying degrees of temperatures across the country. However, few cases of localised thundery showers are expected for portions of coast and the inland areas from late afternoon into the evening.

**NB:** *Relatively cool night and early morning temperatures are expected over the northern sector.*
