SUMMARY: This afternoon, sunny conditions with occasional cloudiness will dominate most places within the country with the likelihood of localised thundery showers over portions of the coastline, inland areas and the middle sector from late afternoon into the evening. The northern half of the country will experience varying intensities of dry and hazy conditions throughout the forecast period.
