

WEATHER SUMMARY: The weather conditions over the maritime space are expected to be partly cloudy in the morning, with reduced visibility due to mist. However, there is a 30% likelihood of isolated thunderstorms and rain over areas offshore later in the morning. Periods of sunshine are expected over the coast in the afternoon.
