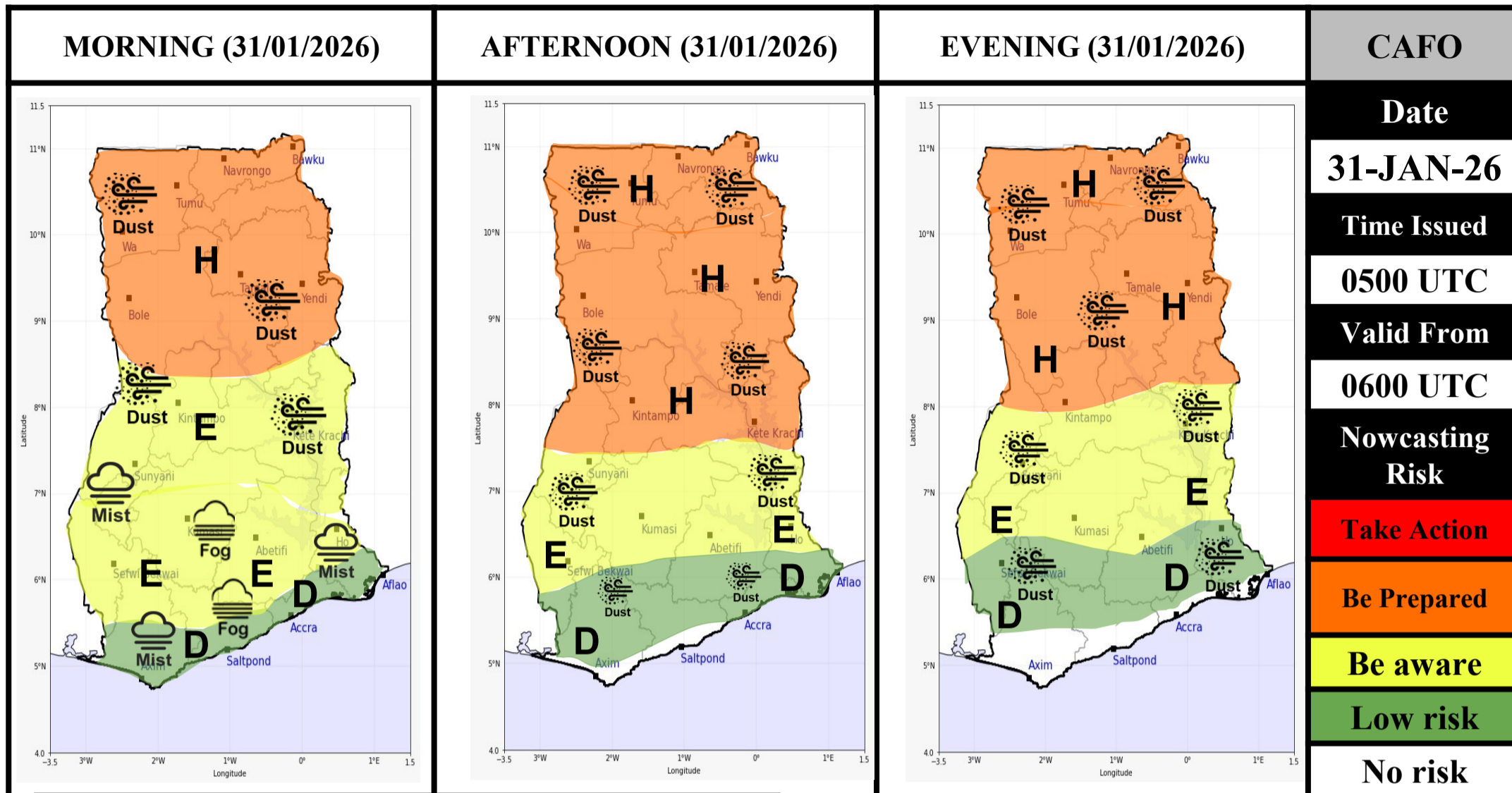




## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** Mist or fog patches will form along the coastal, forest and hilly areas, leading to reduced visibility in the early hours of the day. Varying intensities of dry and hazy conditions will prevail across the country throughout the forecast period with sunny weather dominating during the afternoon hours.

**NB:** Relatively cold weather is expected during the night and early morning hours over the northern and transition sectors

**CAUTION!**

- Motorist are advised to use fog lights and drive at safe speeds due to deteriorated visibility.
- The public, especially in the northern sector, is urged to handle naked fires with caution due to the dry conditions to prevent fire outbreaks.
