

WEATHER: In the afternoon, the marine regions of Ghana will experience sunny intervals along with some clouds. Throughout the afternoon and into the evening, there is a 40% chance of isolated light to moderate rain and thunderstorms developing along the west and east coasts, as well as offshore.

NB: STRONG WINDS ARE EXPECTED THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE MARITIME SPACE, ESPECIALLY OVER THE EASTERN OFFSHORE REGIONS.
