WEATHER: During the forecast period, the marine area is expected to experience varying cloud cover. However, there is a 60% chance of isolated light to moderate rain and thunderstorms across the marine space during the midnight and morning hours. As the day progresses into the afternoon, sunny spells with occasional clouds are anticipated to emerge across the maritime region.
