

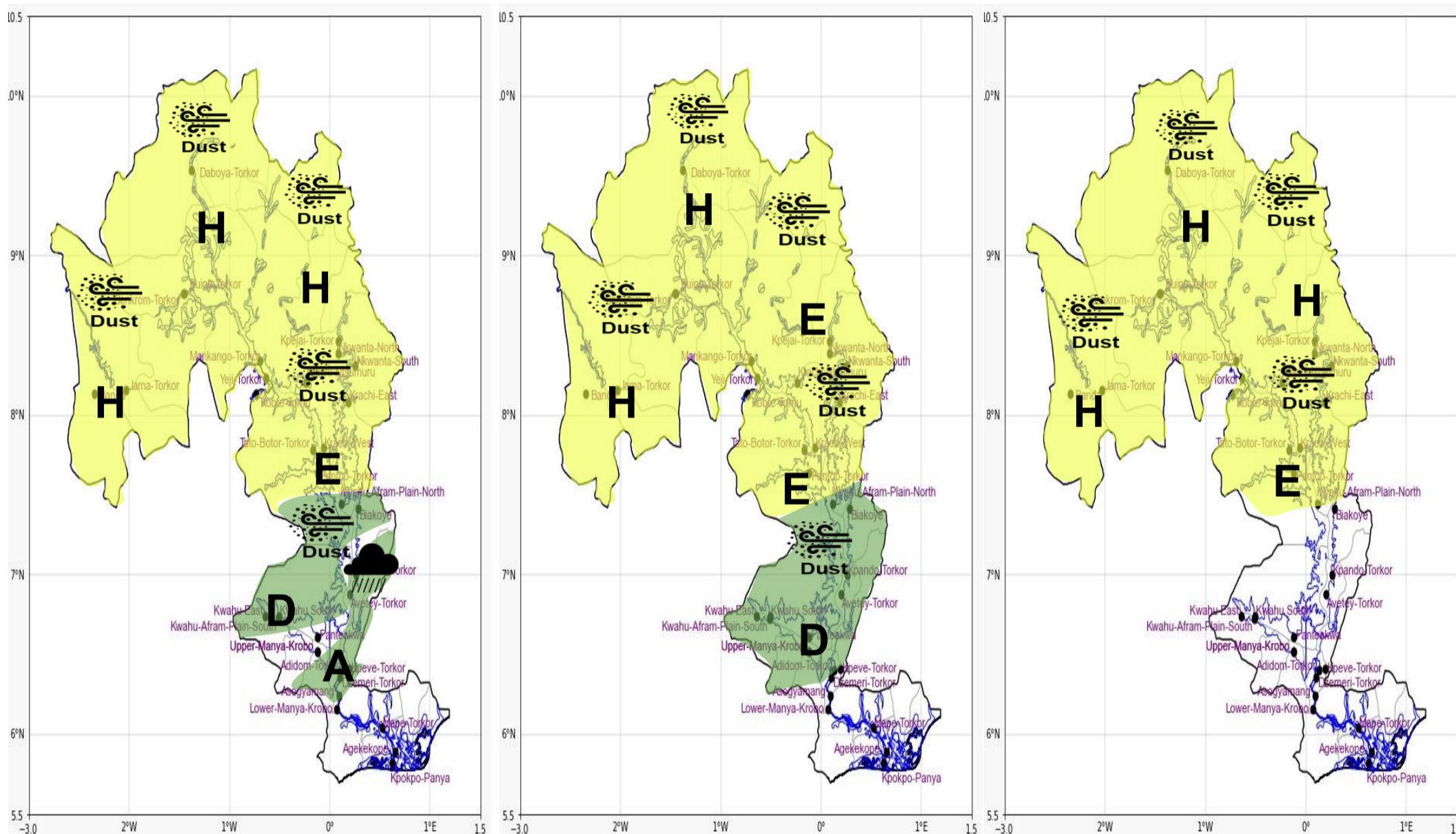


INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

In the afternoon, sunny conditions prevail across the lake and its surroundings, with fairly dry, slightly hazy weather in a few areas of the southern sector. There is a 30% chance of thunderstorms and rain in isolated parts of the southern portion of the lake later in the afternoon and into the early evening. The northern and middle sectors are expected to be dry and hazy throughout the forecast period.
