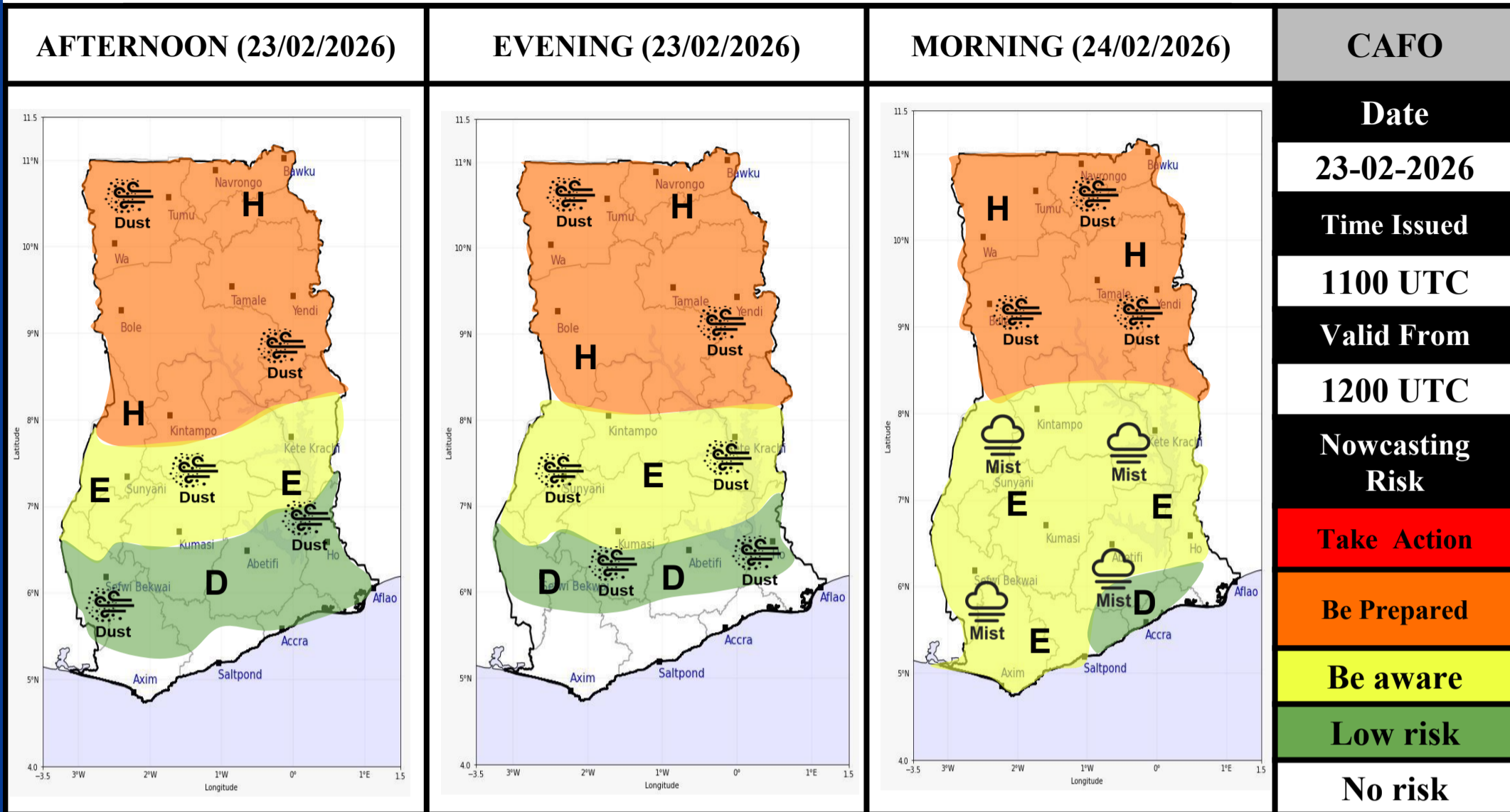


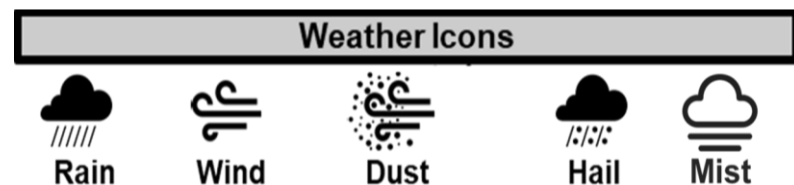


## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** This afternoon, fairly dry and hazy sunshine will dominate most areas within southern Ghana. However, localised thunderstorms or rain will affect a few areas slightly north of the coastline from late afternoon into the evening. Northern Ghana will experience dry and hazy weather varying intensities throughout the forecast period with visibility ranging from 3000m and 8000m.

**CAUTION:** Due to the prevailing dry conditions, the public, especially in the transition and northern sectors, is strongly advised to handle naked flames with extreme caution to prevent fire outbreaks.
