

WEATHER SUMMARY

The Country's maritime area is expected to experience partly cloudy skies, with early morning mist potentially reducing visibility before sunny periods develop in the afternoons. Isolated thunderstorms of varying intensity are forecast along the coast and offshore during the early part of the period, while sea conditions are expected to remain calm throughout.
