

WEATHER SUMMARY

The marine area is expected to remain generally fair, with sunny afternoon; particularly along the coastlines- calm seas, relatively low tides and light winds. Fog patches are anticipated to reduce visibility during the early morning hours but is expected to dissipate by late morning as temperatures rise. However, there remains a 40% chance of isolated light to moderate rains with or without thunder activities, mainly over offshore waters.
