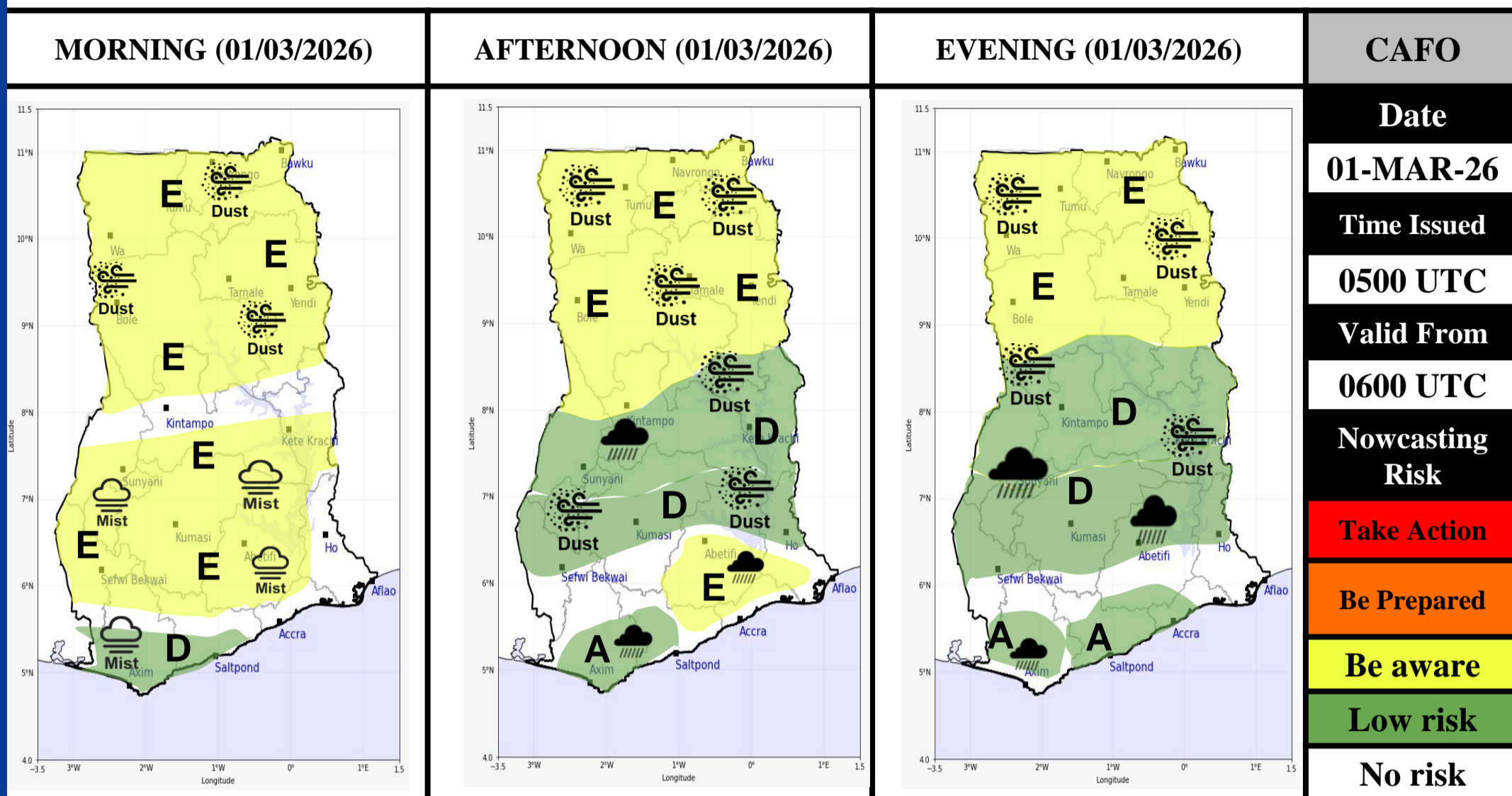




## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** Mist or fog patches will affect parts of southern Ghana this morning, reducing visibility, while the northern sector remains variably dry and hazy throughout the forecast period. Sunny intervals will prevail across all sectors of the country during the afternoon, with thunderstorms or rain likely over inland areas of the coast, as well as the middle and transition belts from mid-afternoon into the evening.
