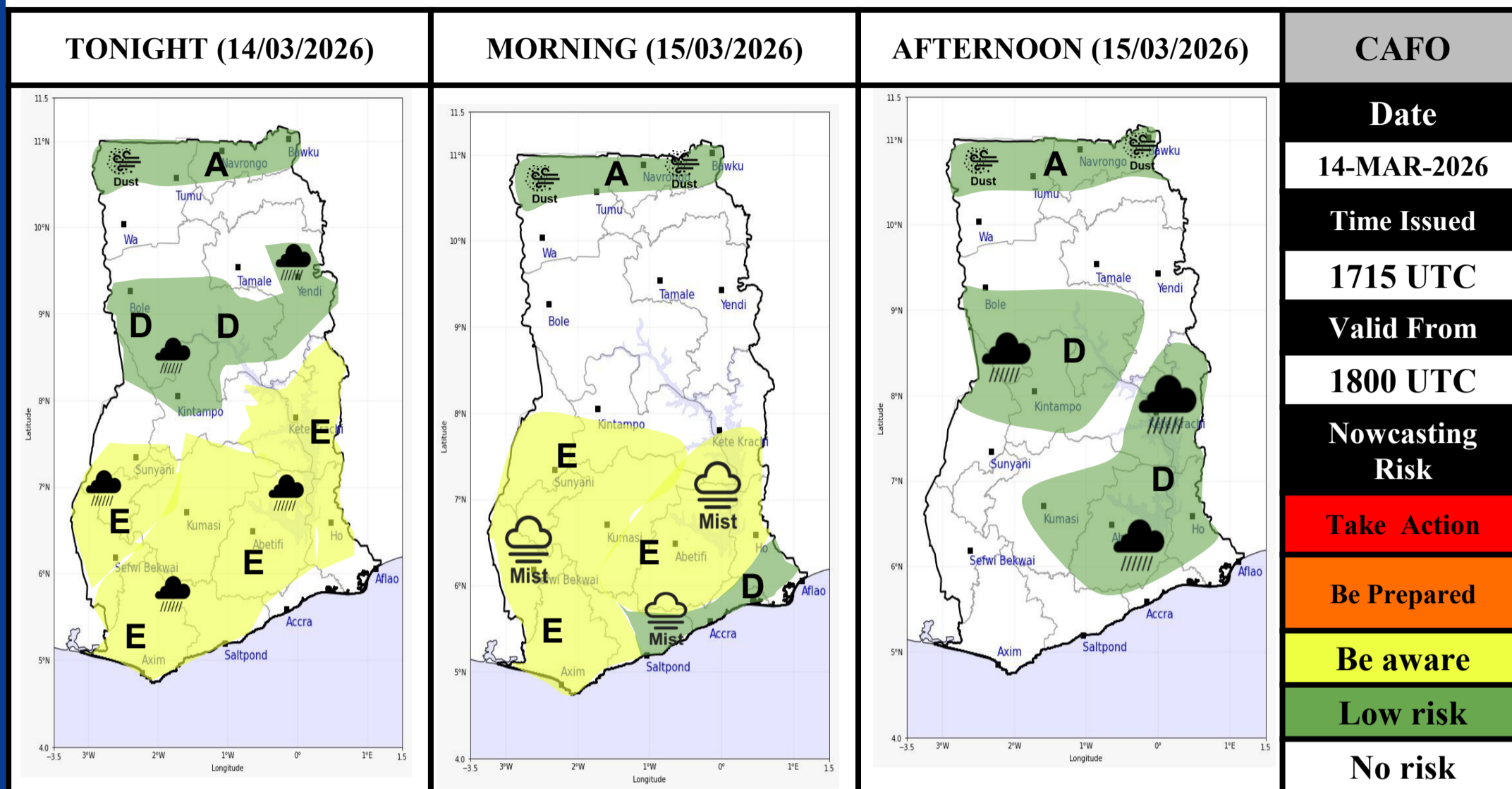

SUMMARY: The anticipated thunderstorms or rainfall referenced earlier today has rather generated extensive cloud cover over most parts of the coast and inland areas, while triggering localised thunderstorms or rain over some areas along the coast, slightly north of the coast, the middle, transition and savannah belt. These conditions are likely to persist into tonight. Mist and fog patches will form along the coast, mountainous and forest zones early tomorrow morning which may affect visibility.
