

WEATHER SUMMARY

The forecast for the maritime areaaaa this week indicates mostly broken cloud cover, with intermittent sunshine expected along the coastline throughout much of the week. Mariners are advised to proceed with caution during the first 48 hours due to elevated sea waves and moderate winds, particularly along the eastern coast. Additionally, early morning mist may reduce visibility at dawn, although conditions are expected to improve shortly after sunrise.
