WEATHER: Few clouds are expected over the marine area during the forecast period, resulting in sunny conditions this afternoon and partly cloudy skies by evening. However, there is about a 30% chance of light, isolated, and occasional rainfall along the east coast later in the afternoon. Overall, sea conditions across Ghana’s economic zone are expected to remain calm.
