





## OUTLOOK FOR GHANA'S MARINE SPACE IMPACT-BASED FORECAST (WEEKEND) 21032026 - 23032026

### WEATHER SUMMARY

The marine area is expected to experience mostly cloudy weather, with sunny afternoons along the coastlines. There is a (40-60)% chance of isolated thunderstorms and rainfall, especially along the coastline and offshore region. The state of the sea is expected to be calm on Saturday and gradually become rough, accompanied by relatively strong winds throughout the forecast period.
