

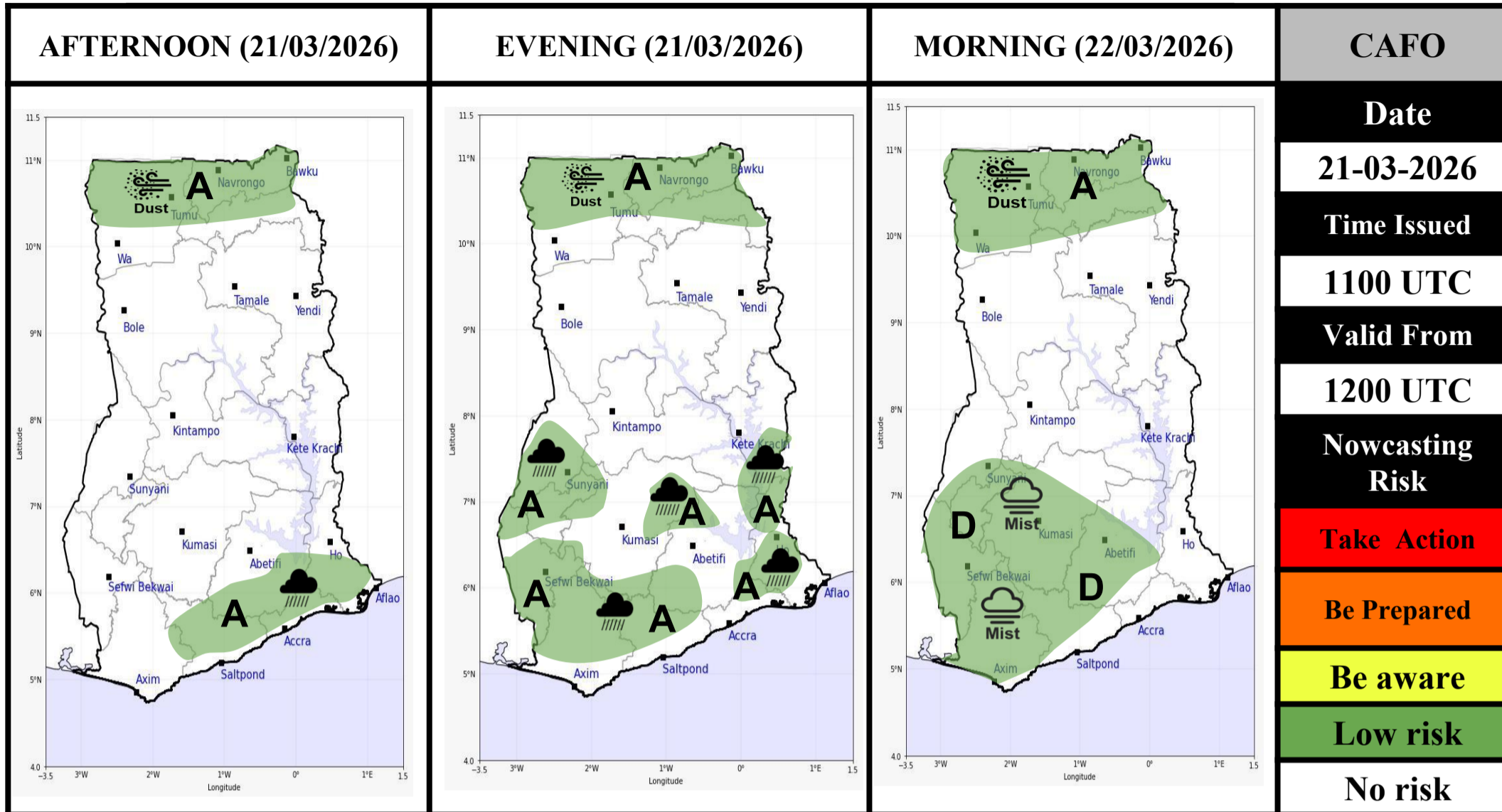

**SUMMARY:** Generally, hot and sunny weather will prevail across the country this afternoon, with more intense conditions expected over the northern half. However, isolated rain showers and thunderstorms may affect parts of the middle sector and inland coastal areas from late afternoon into the evening. Slightly hazy conditions will persist over the upper regions of the northern sector throughout the forecast period.
