





## 24-HOUR IMPACT-BASED FORECAST FOR GHANA

**SUMMARY:** Early this morning, mist or fog patches are likely to develop in some coastal, forest, and hilly areas. Parts of the northern and transition sectors may experience slight to moderate rain. As the day advances, sunny conditions will be observed across the country. Later in the day, from mid-afternoon into the evening hours, thunderstorms or rain of varying intensities are anticipated over the northern sector, the transition belt, as well as the forest zones.
