



WEATHER SUMMARY

Mostly cloudy weather is expected over the maritime regions of our country throughout the forecast duration, with brief periods of sunshine in the afternoon. Cases of thunderstorms and rain with varying intensities are anticipated. The ocean state is expected to be rough throughout the week, with the exception of Tuesday, which is expected to be calm. The expected rains will be preceded by gusty winds ranging between 25 and 30 knots.
